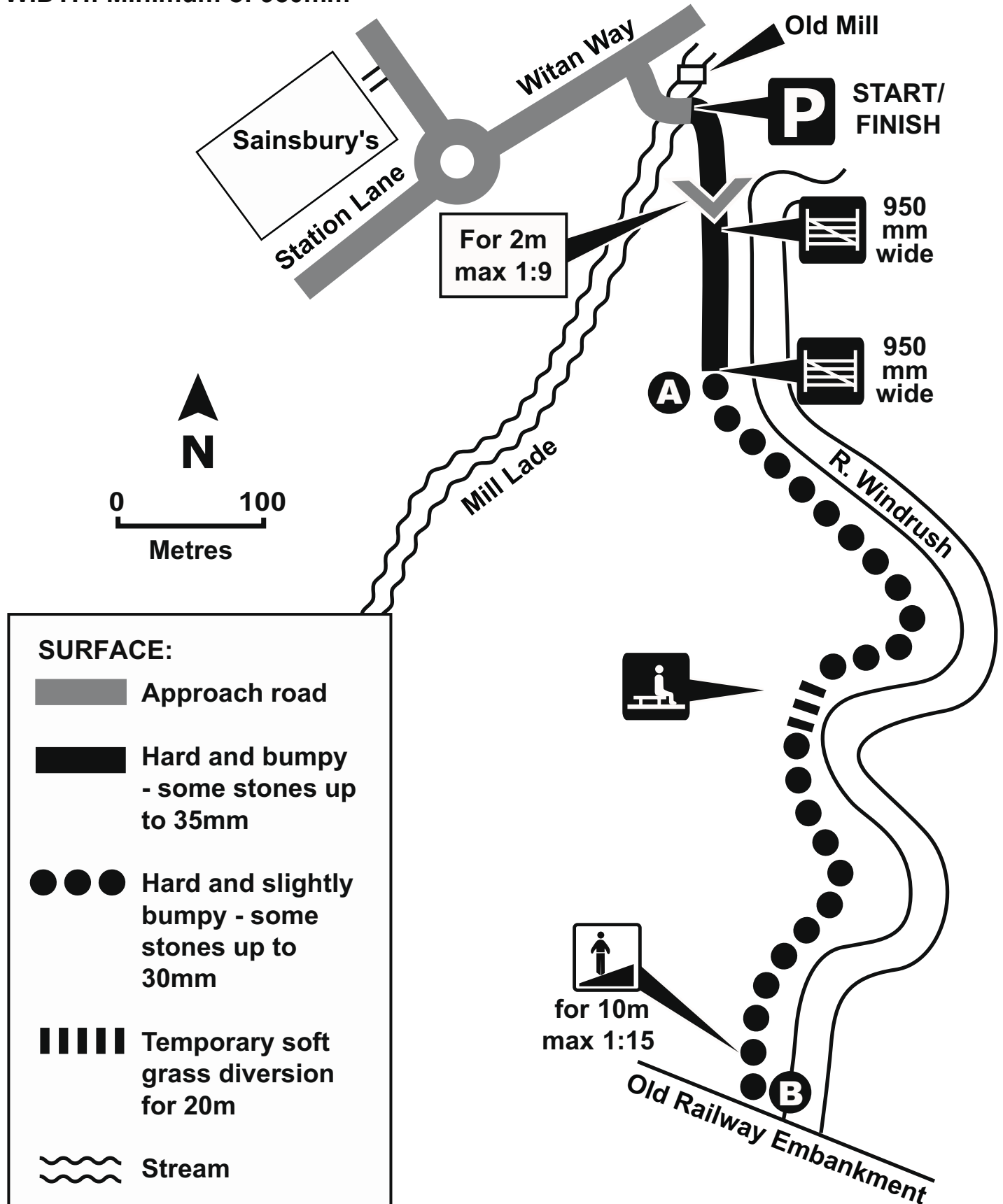
**DISTANCE:** 0.75 miles (1.2km)

# HOW TO GET TO WITNEY MEADOWS

MAP: OS Landranger 164, grid ref SP360091

ROAD: Download free map from [www.streetmap.co.uk](http://www.streetmap.co.uk) - insert grid ref above as a Landranger and click SEARCH. Park near old mill off Witan Way near its junction with Station Lane.

NEAREST FACILITIES:  and  at Sainsbury's (Mon to Sat 7am to 10pm, Sun 10am to 6pm) off Station Lane, 400m by road.

 Parking - for up to 4 cars. Hard, level and slightly bumpy	 Gate	 Accessible toilets
 Slope - points downhill	 Rest Area	 Refreshments

## ROUTE DESCRIPTION

START from car parking follow track through two gates onto riverside path at A:

- A** Follow path for 600 metres to old railway embankment at B
- B** Retrace your route to FINISH



## POINTS OF INTEREST

The meadows are bounded by the mill lade to the west and the River Windrush to the east. The flower rich meadows are at their best in May and June and are cut for hay.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The mill building is redundant so please keep away. The gates are not currently accessible to users of personal mobility vehicles. There is a temporary diversion across short grass for 20m avoiding a bank slip.
