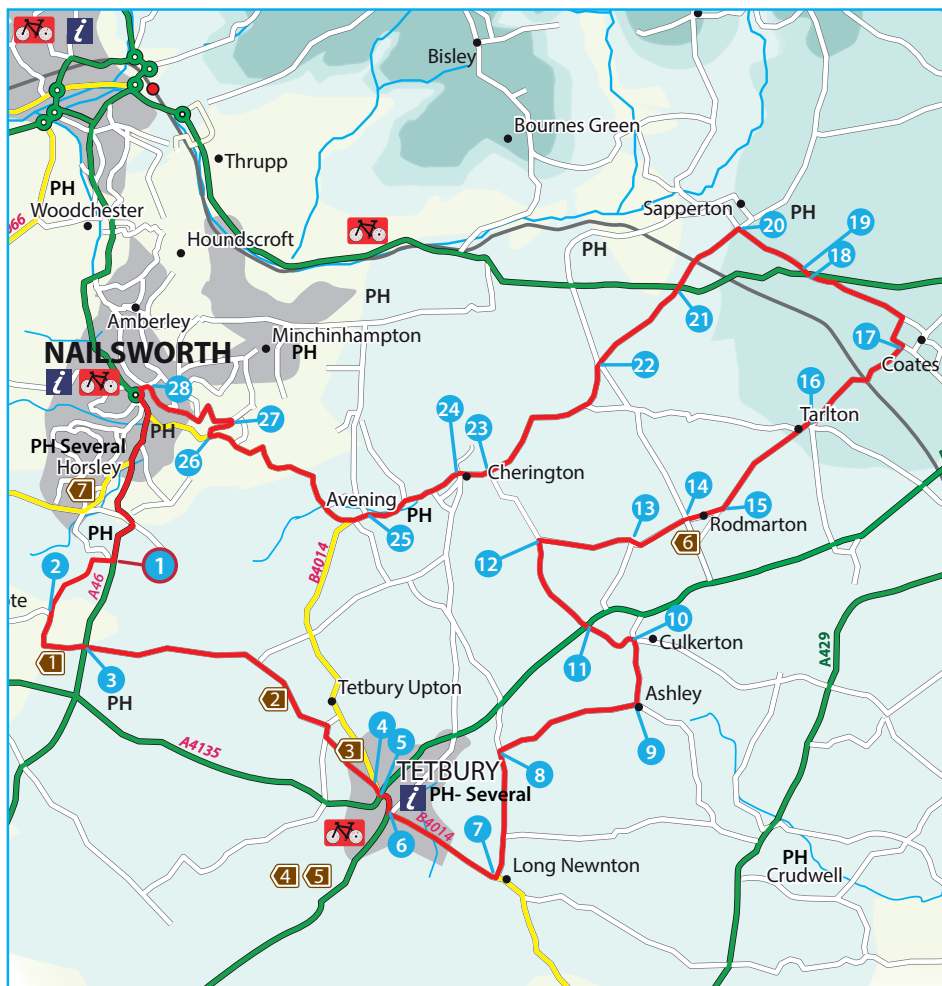


Nailsworth Circular

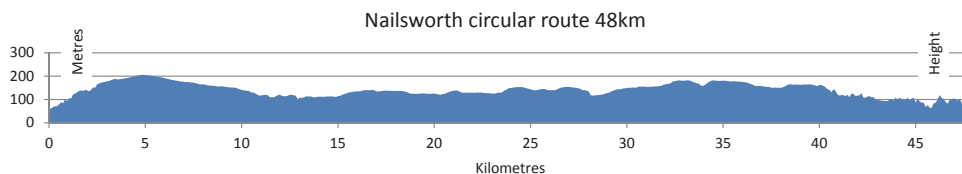
Route 1



- 6 At mini roundabout straight on.
- 7 TL SP LONG NEWNTON/CRUDWELL/ CIRENCESTER.
- 8 TR SP ASHLEY/CULKERTON.
- 9 At T Junction TL.
- 10 At crossroads TL SP TETBURY/CHERINGTON.
- 11 At cross roads, straight over SP CHERINGTON.
- 12 TR SP HAZLETON/RODMARTON.
- 13 Bear right then left SP RODMARTON/TARLTON.
- 14 At crossroads straight over SP RODMARTON/ TARLTON.
- 15 At grass triangle junction TL.
- 16 Take 2nd left SP COATES.
- 17 At T junction TL SP SAPPERTON/STROUD.
- 18 At T junction TL SP STROUD.
- 19 TR SP SAPPERTON/EDGEWORTH. **Extreme care crossing the A419.**
- 20 At crossroads TL SP CHERINGTON/STROUD.
- 21 At crossroads, straight over SP CHERINGTON. **Extreme care crossing the A419.**
- 22 At crossroads, straight over SP TETBURY/ CHERINGTON.
- 23 At T junction TR SP TETBURY/AVENING.
- 24 TR SP AVENING.
- 25 At T Junction TL SP AVENING/NAILSWORTH/ TETBURY.
- 26 TR SP MINCHINHAMPTON. **Care crossing the B4014.**
- 27 TL SP PENSILE Road.
- 28 At T junction TL and make your way back into Nailsworth.

Head for the main junction roundabout A46/ B4014 at the bottom of the town and TL towards SP BATH and make the steady ascent out of the town along the A46.

- 1 TR into a quiet lane just past Tippotts Pub. **Extreme care crossing the A46.**
- 2 TL.
- 3 At cross roads straight over SP CHAVENAGE.
- 4 At T junction TR.
- 5 At junction direction straight on.



At a Glance

Apart from brief stints along A and B roads, the route follows quiet unclassified lanes through rolling Cotswold Countryside. Strenuous in one or two short bursts.

Grade - Moderate

Distance - 30 miles / 48 km

Nailsworth Circular

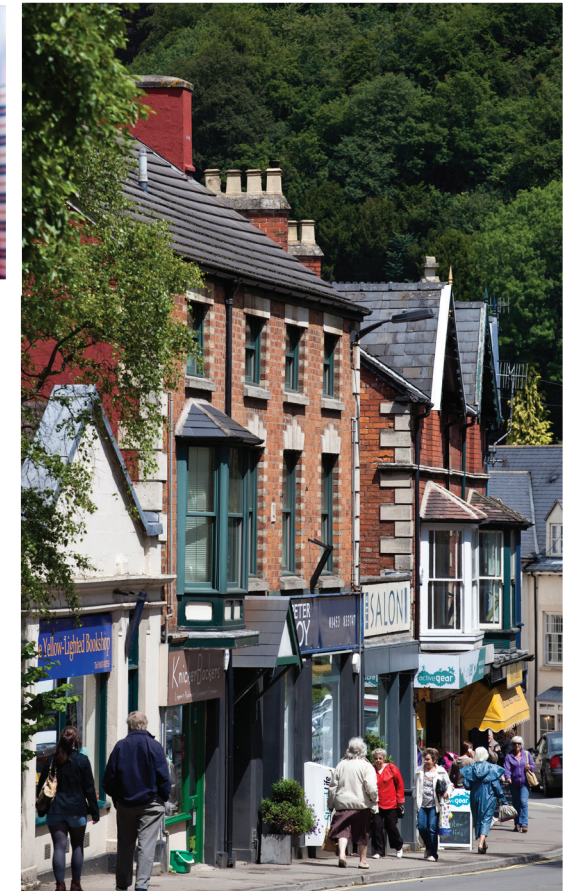
Nailsworth is a lively, artistic town nestling in a wooded valley and renowned for its award-winning restaurants, pubs, cafes and other food outlets including a celebrated local bakery (home to The Fabulous Baker Brothers) and food emporium, as well as some lovely, small independent shops. There is a mill trail and Nailsworth has the largest number of working water wheels per square mile in the country. Ruskin Mill (a centre for artistic activity) and the Stroudwater textile Trust's Weaving Shed at Gigg Mill are nearby. An eight-mile cycle-way follows the old railway line to Stonehouse. Close by is the Nailsworth Ladder leading to National Trust common land and the mysterious and haunted Woodchester Mansion. The Nailsworth Festival takes place annually with a programme of art and music events.

The next market town to stop is Tetbury, which has a market house dating back to the 17th century used for the sale of wool and yarn at the heart of the town. Tetbury has many beautiful and historic buildings and the skyline is dominated by the magnificent spire of the Parish Church of St May the Virgin and certainly worth a look. A walk down the old Chipping Steps and round into Gumstool Hill will reveal another part of Tetbury's history, with 17th century weavers cottages. Not far from Tetbury you will find the national arboretum of Westonbirt and the area is famous for its Royal connections with Highgrove.

Continuing on the route you will go through many small Cotswolds Villages including, Kingscote, Rodmarton, Culkerton, Coates, Frampton Mansell and Avening.
